Academic Calendar for the Session 2024-2025

The Department of Education, Government of Assam has instructed to develop a uniform Academic Calendar for elementary, secondary and higher secondary classes and has directed to implement the same in all Schools of Assam. Accordingly, Assam Higher Secondary Education Council has prepared this Academic Calendar for the session 2024-2025 (1st April, 2024-31st March, 2025) for Higher Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools in the State.

The monthly Academic Wall Calendar is for all Higher Secondary Schools and Senior Secondary Schools for the Session 2024-25, imparting Higher Secondary Course of AHSEC.

It is expected that the Institutions will follow this calendar towards improving the academic atmosphere in our State.

General Instructions :

1. The Heads of the institution(s) shall convene meeting with the teaching staff conveniently to discuss and finalize the academic activities in the light of this Calendar. The meeting shall finalize the class routine as per model routine given with this Calendar.
2. The Heads of the institution(s) shall constitute different Committees from amongst the teachers like
 - I. Academic Committee,
 - II. Examination Committee,
 - III. Festival Celebration Committee,
 - IV. Students' Activities Committee,
 - V. Parent Teacher Relation Committee,
 - VI. Unit Test Committee,
 - VII. Co-curricular Activity Committee etc.These Committees will be responsible for smooth functioning of different programs of the Institutions.
3. Lessonwise distributions of the key subjects of Arts, Science & Commerce stream have been displayed in every month of the Academic Calendar. These are just some examples of lesson distributions in this calendar. **All teachers will prepare monthly lesson distribution of respective subject to cover the syllabus within the period.**
4. Head of the Institutions shall ask the teachers to prepare subjectwise work schedule of those subjects which are not included in the action plan of this calendar and discuss the syllabi contents amongst the teachers of respective subject. The Academic Committee will take initiative in this plan.
5. The regular H.S. class shall begin from 9.15 A.M. onwards, everyday
6. Full classes will be taken on all working days including Saturdays. **Saturday shall not be treated as half working day.**
7. The Head of the Institutions should ensure and maintain the norms laid down in the Rules & Regulations notified by AHSEC time to time in recognition, academic permission, conduct of examinations etc.
8. The Institutions will prepare their own class routine, by following the model routine of AHSEC published in this calendar, 2024-25
9. The class routine as included in this Calendar shall be strictly followed in such a manner that the duration of period and total number of classes per subject are not reduced.
10. The first period for Higher Secondary Classes is for 45 minutes duration. The last period is of 35 minutes. The other classes must be 40 minutes in all the institutions. It is to be maintained strictly.
11. **Dates of Holidays may be changed subject to Govt. Notification.**
12. The Unit Tests shall be conducted as per schedule mentioned in the Academic Calendar. The records of such tests should be analyzed immediately after completion of each test and should be taken necessary remedial measures for academic improvement of the students. The Unit Test Committee will take initiative for proper execution.
13. The AHSEC will issue necessary instructions in due course of time for holding of H.S. First/Final Examination, submission of registration forms, examination forms etc.
14. At the beginning of the academic session, it is imperative to discuss the syllabus and textbook for deriving the skills/competencies envisaged in the curriculum and syllabus. The Academic Committee will take initiative with the supervision of the Head of the institution.
15. It is expected that the Head of the Institutions will take necessary steps for proper implementation of this Academic Calendar for achieving desired level of academic improvement of the students in general, and of the institutions in particular.
16. The Academic Calendar must be followed by the concerned Institutions for maintaining healthy atmosphere.
17. **Any suggestion for improvement of academic activities at +2 stage is highly solicited for designing future course of action.**

Activities for the Higher Secondary Schools/Sr.Secondary Schools for the Mental Health of Students

Sudden break out of COVID-19 has brought a wave of change to every aspect of human life. Mental health was not an exception. With the changing world, the mental health of human beings, specially of students has drastically degraded. Keeping themselves within locked area, no outing, no playing in play ground, no face to face interaction with friends, no physical activity, learning only through screen, scarcity of mobile, problems with network, degradation of financial status of parents etc, affect the mental health of our students. It has possessed a major challenge to keep the mental health of students intact. Social isolations, degrading health condition, lock down were the major threat to mental health under the prevailing circumstances. It is of utmost important to keep the mental health intact of the students.

As long as the physical classes have been starting at Schools/educational institutions, it is our duty to keep up the mental health of the students. The teachers should take the responsibility for growing sound mental health of the students along with their routined teaching. The head of the institutions should take initiative for better mental health of all students.

For this purpose, the educational institutions can take some activities like -

1. The educational institutions can organise **counselling sessions by inviting a psychologist**. Students should be given opportunities to have a face to face session with the psychologist.
2. The institutions can **arrange popular talk** by inviting a psychologist.
3. Can invite motivational speaker to **address the common problem of the students** and to provide the techniques to cope up with it.
4. G. Stanley Hall (American psychologist) referred to adolescence as the period of "storm and stress". During this stage an adolescent goes through various changes and they are exposed to vivid emotions. At this stage, the tension related to career also arises. They are unable to recognise their aptitude and are mostly confused with which career path they should opt for, depending on their calibre. In this regard, the Educational institutions may organise some **Talks or discussions regarding the career opportunities and guide** them by inviting some professional career mentors.
5. It is very important to keep the minds occupied. To ensure that the schedules are packed, and minds are alert. Free time should be used to keep the individuals busy through various activities like art, craft, music, cooking, play etc. It will not only enable them to use their leisure properly but also develop the creative ability of individuals. **Workshops** can be organised by inviting some local artist of various sphere e.g- art and craft, music, dance, recitation, creative writing etc for the students.
6. **Skill enhancement** programmes also can be arranged for the students which may help them in the future.
7. In teaching-learning process, the teachers should handle the students very delicately, so that students will not be more stressed. Teachers/Principals as well as the guardians should inspire students at all time for joyful teaching learning.

These are some suggestions from AHSEC. The Principals/Teachers may take some innovative ideas for improving the mental health of the students according to their positions.

To keep safe from COVID-19 Precautionary measures to be taken by Hols/ Teachers/ Students.

1. School Premises should be sanitised once in a week.
2. A minimum distance should be maintained between each other.
3. Cleaning and disinfection of the classrooms, washrooms, common rooms etc. to be done regularly.
4. Mask to be worn to cover face and nose by all students, teachers, Principals, non teaching staffs.
5. Hand washing should be done frequently by soap.
6. Water facility (For drinking and non-drinking uses) should be well and proper.
7. Classrooms should be well ventilated.
8. SOP as issued by the Govt. of Assam time to time due to COVID-19 should be followed.
9. The nearest hospitals should be contacted in case of fever, cough, difficulty in breathing, medical emergency.
10. Community awareness for safety measures for COVID-19 should be developed.
11. Total Vaccination to all students of H.S. 1st year and H.S. 2nd year (two doses) should be ensured,
12. If not, necessary arrangement should be taken with the help of health department.

INFORMATIONS REGARDING CHANGE IN SYLLABUS & CURRICULUM

There are some special and significant informations to all concerned Schools / Senior Secondary / Degree Colleges / Universities who impart the Higher Secondary Courses under AHSEC.

- AHSEC has introduced a new elective subject, named by 'Bihu' for the students of Arts Stream from the Academic Session 2020-21 onwards. In this regard, AHSEC has informed to all concerned principals through a notification no. অঃ উঃ মাঃ শিঃ স / শৈক্ষিক / বিহু / ৩০৭ / ২০১৯ / ২৪০৬৫, dated 12-06-2020. Accordingly, AHSEC has developed two textbooks for H.S 1st and H.S. 2nd year. The name of the textbook for the subject is "অসমৰ বিহু উৎসৱ". Both the textbooks are available in the open market for the students in revised edition.
- AHSEC has updated the Curriculum of **Commerce Stream** to be implemented from the Academic Session 2020-21.

- AHSEC has introduced **new vocational elective subjects** for the students in **Arts, Science, and Commerce streams**. In this connection, the following is the trade wise fixation of job roles for classes of XI & XII, which was approved by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Govt. of India under NSQF.

The Principals of concerned institution are asked to notify the same for the benefit of the students and they may contact directly the Rastriya Madhyamik Siksha Abhijan (RMSA) for syllabus/textbooks etc. in this regard.

Accordingly, the following textbooks on the above subjects have been prepared with the help of Bodo Sahitya Sabha and now the textbooks are available in the open market

- i. Environmental Education
- ii. Introductory Micro-Economics
- iii. Statistics for Economics
- iv. Political Theory
- v. Indian Constitution at Work
- vi. Logic and Philosophy
- vii. Indian Physical Environment
- viii. Fundamental of Physical Geography
- ix. Swadesh Adhyayan
- x. Education

For inauguration of the textbooks, a programme was organized by the Bodo Sahitya Sabha on 02.08.2023 at Tamulpur H.S. School, where Sri Promod Bodo, Hon'ble CEM, BTR was also present and graced the occasion.

Presently, the textbooks of the respective subjects for H.S. 2nd year have been developed by AHSEC with the help of Bodo Sahitya Sabha to be implemented from 2024-25 Academic Session. These books are also available in the market for the students.

9. Introduction of project works

In the light of National Education Policy, 2020, AHSEC has introduced project work in some of the subjects.

The marks considered for the project work is 20 marks out of 100. So in these subjects, the marks in the theory part is 80 marks.

Accordingly, AHSEC has developed a SOP for project works.

The Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for implementation of Project Works

Background

AHSEC has introduced project works on few subjects since 2018-19 academic session keeping in view that project based learning helps students get involved in their learning. Through project based learning, students get to know to identify problems and their solutions and as such gain necessary knowledge to find plausible solutions, which give successful outcomes.

Project based learning for the students of H.S. 1st and 2nd year is only possible with the proper guidance of the teachers. A teacher needs to guide his/her students in designing projects based on their abilities, keeping in view that the project work builds their confidence. So, involvement of both the teachers and their student's are most important for accomplishing a project- individually or in a group whichever is convenient for a particular teacher.

Ready reckoner to implement the Project Works

1. Students may be given project individually or in a group depending on the total number of students in a particular subject.
2. The concerned teacher must provide guidance to the students in selection of project and its preparation and completion.
3. Field visit by the students under the guidance of concerned teacher may be undertaken as per requirement of the project or if necessary.
4. The project should be completed at least one month prior to the final examination.
5. Project must be in own handwriting of the student in A4 size paper (on single side).
6. Every guide teacher should have the responsibility to ensure the activities of project work to be done by all individual students.
7. The Head of the Institution must ensure the submission of the Project works within stipulated timeframe.
8. The project report must be preserved properly by the institution. AHSEC may at any time ask the institution to submit the report in AHSEC office, if necessary.
9. Certificate of Guide also annexed at **Annexure-I**.
10. Certificate of Head of the Institution annexed at **Annexure-II**.
11. Declaration by the student annexed at **Annexure-III**.
12. The student who has completed & submitted the project works may be awarded atleast the required passing marks and same will have to be ensured by the Head of the Institution.
13. Head of the Institution will ensure that all the deserving students must be awarded marks according to their merits.
14. If a student fails in the project work, the Head of the Institution must submit a report to the Controller of Examination mentioning the reason of failure.
15. External/Internal Examiner shall be appointed by the HoD of the concerned department in consultation with the Head of the Institution.
16. The earlier notification of AHSEC, vide No AHSEC/ACA/144/99/B-111/374 dated 08/12/2022 shall be applicable for the purpose of distribution of marks on project works.

Assam Higher Secondary Education Council has made an endeavor in the year (2021-22) by developing an online admission portal namely- "DARPAN" for hassle free admission into HS First Year Class under AHSEC. Information related to the admission process, Prospectus of Institutions etc. are provided to students through the portal. The selection on merit of the student is also notified through push SMS to the students as well as they can also check their selection by logging into the portal. Confirmation of admission by the institution concerned is also made available through online. Once admission is confirmed by the institution through Institution's login, students' status of admission process is updated and the status can be checked by logging into the portal. Online institution change, subject(s) change and stream change provision for HS First Year students are also made available in the portal to make the process hassle free for the students as well as for the institutions concerned. The "DARPAN" online admission portal is likely to eliminate multiple admissions by one student. Now, AHSEC has easy and quick access of records and databases of students as well as institutions of all categories such as Recognised/Permitted/Non-Permitted institutions.

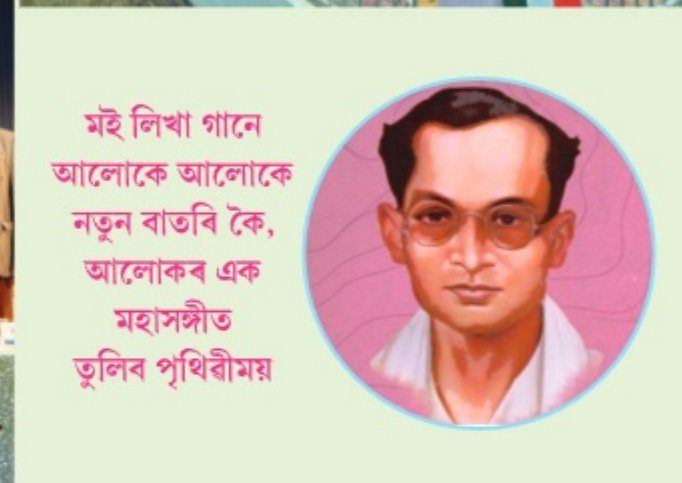

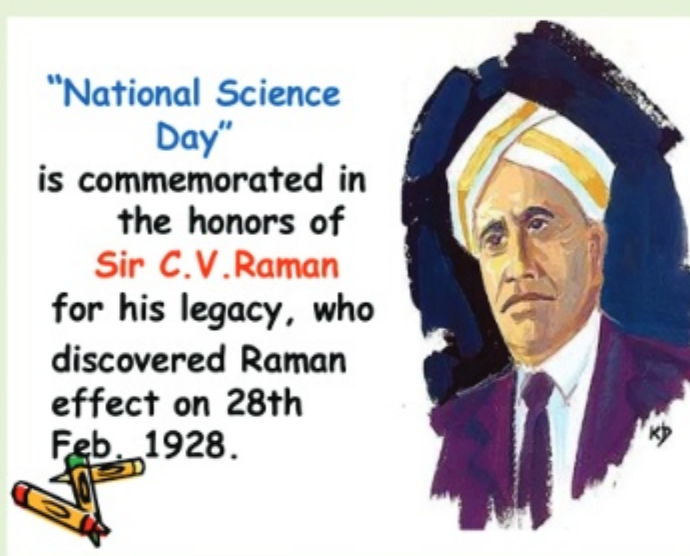

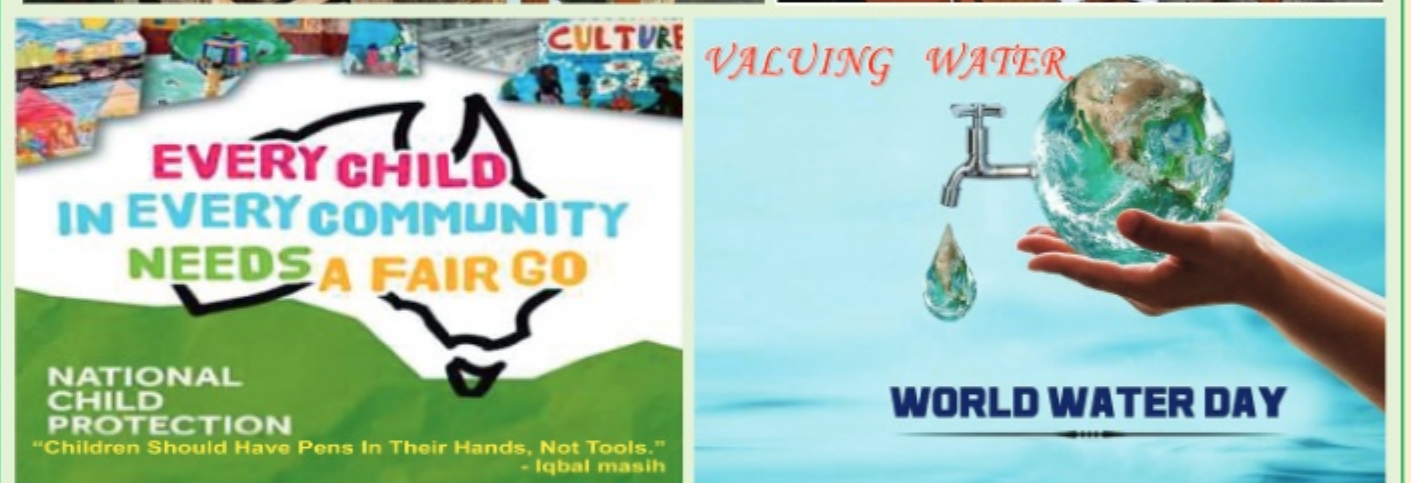
